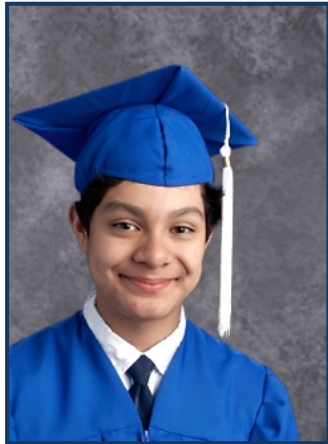


St. James the Apostle School – Principal’s Corner

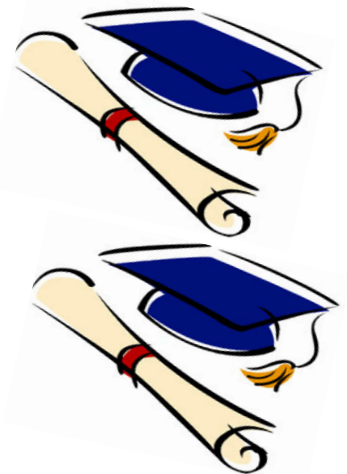
